**IMPARTIAL HEARING OFFICER APPOINTMENT AND
COMPENSATION**

The Board of Education will appoint impartial hearing officers (IHO), as needed, to hear complaints regarding the identification, evaluation, or placement of students with disabilities, or the provision of a free appropriate public

other applicable procedures described in Commissioner's regulations

1. Make a determination on the sufficiency of the due process complaint that will be heard at the hearing within five days of receiving such a request; and
2. Initiate the hearing within the first 14 days after either:

~~The date on which the parent receives written notice that the parents~~

resolve their differences prior to commencement of the hearing, or met but were unable to reach agreement; or

- The expiration of the 30-day period beginning with the receipt of the due process complaint, whichever occurs first.

Cancellation

The district shall attempt to provide an Impartial Hearing Officer with two (2) business days' advance notice of the cancellation or re-scheduling of
