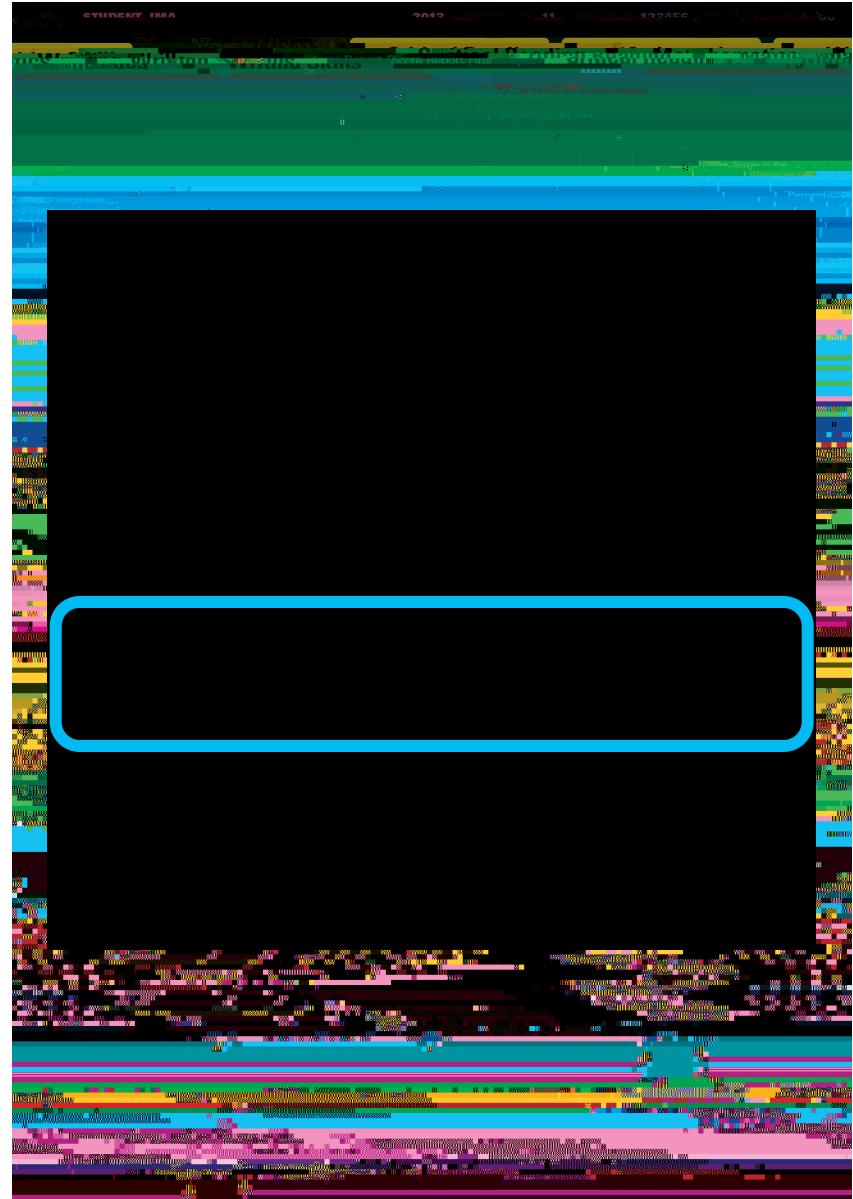

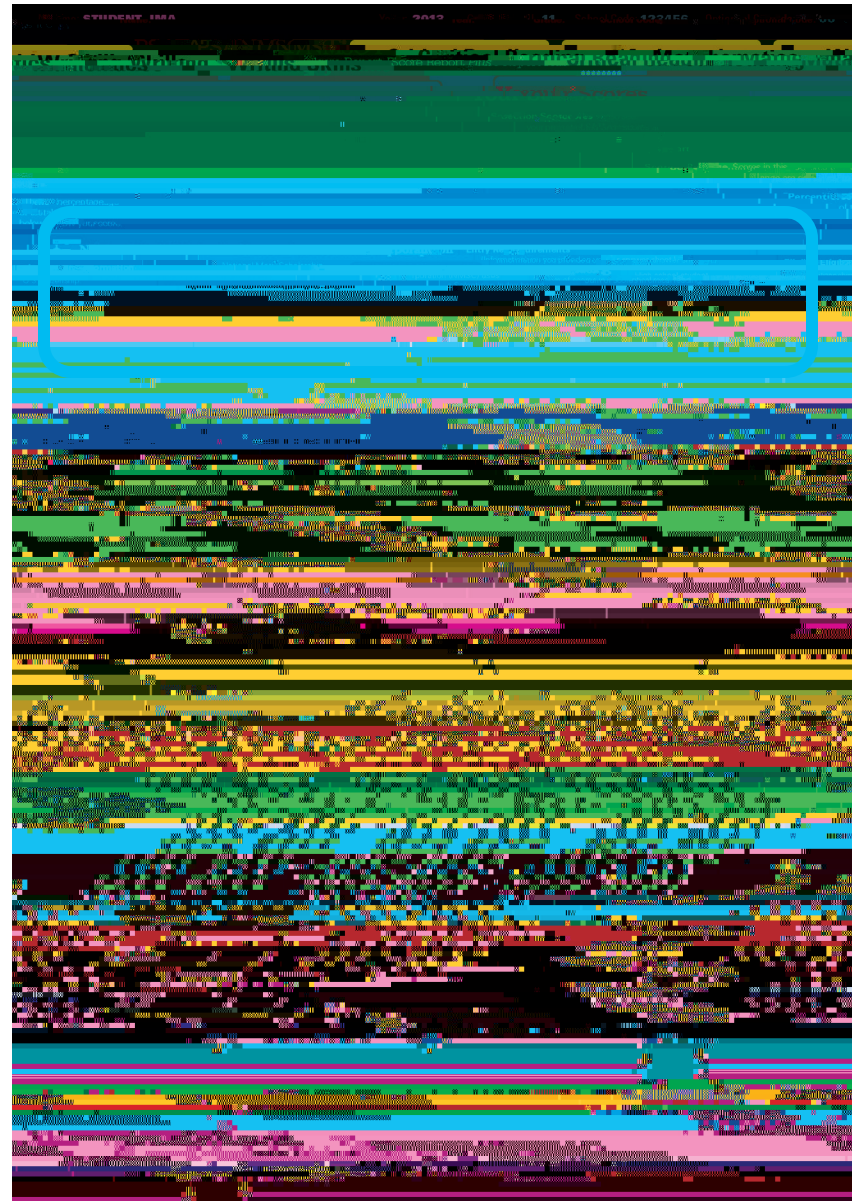
Percentile

If it has an asterisk, you do not meet all of the eligibility requirements for the competition.

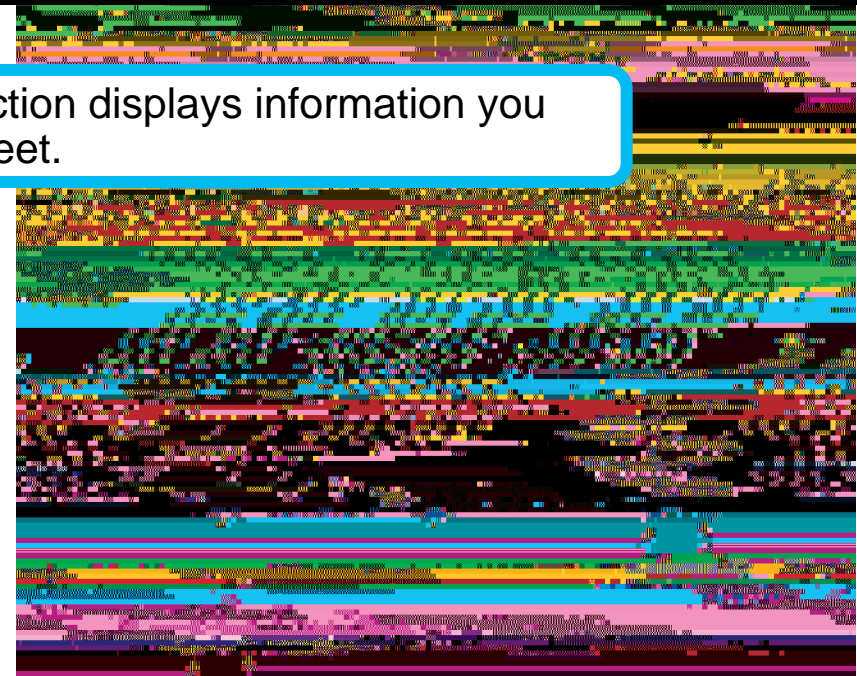
National Merit Scholarship Corporation Information (cont.)

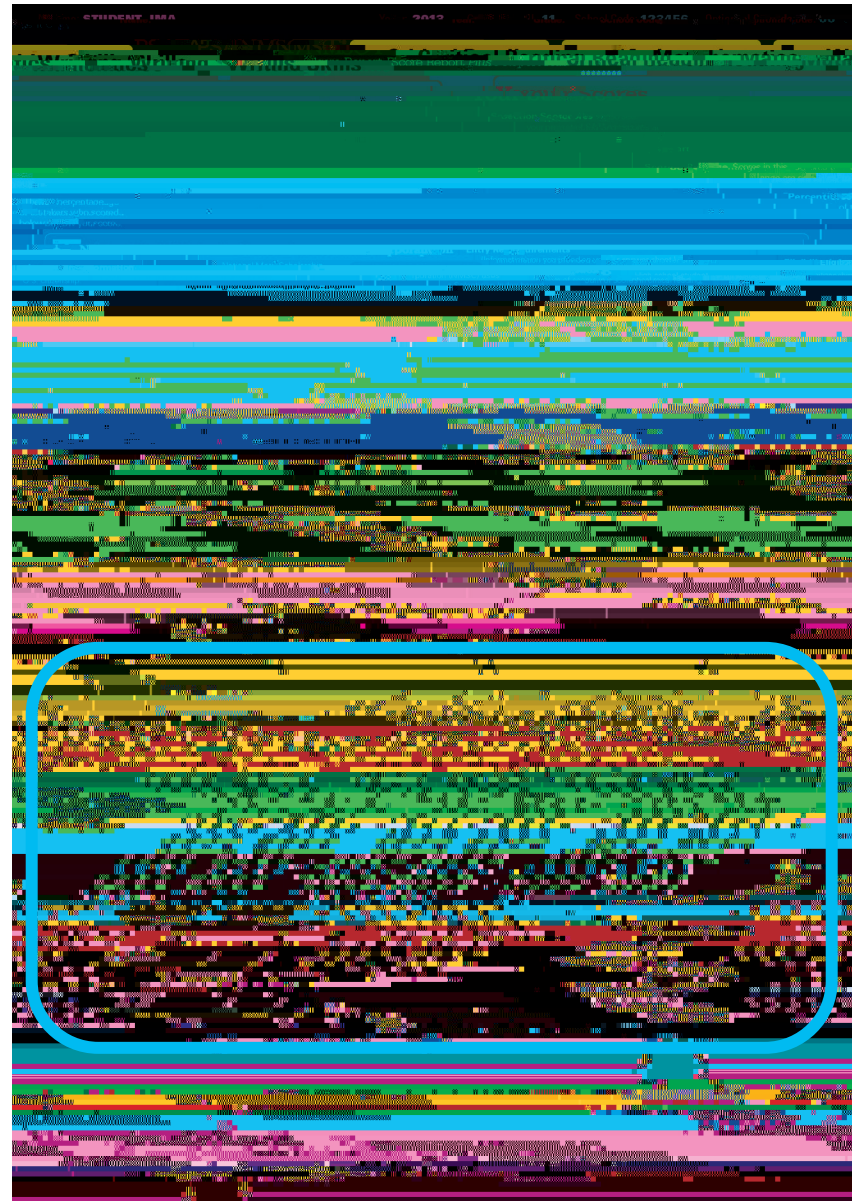


